

Community Activities/Events - 2017

CRITERIA

The Olympic Dam Aboriginal Community Trust (“the Trust”) invites applications from eligible **‘Not for Profit Organisations’** to support the delivery of activities/events through ‘music, art and culture’ for the 2017 calendar year.

ABORIGINAL ‘FAMILY INCORPORATED’ ORGANISATIONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY.

Priority will be given to but not limited to applications that will:

- Contribute to Aboriginal events across the footprint.
- Celebrate, showcase and promote the rich Culture & Diversity of the Aboriginal Community.
- Support access, participation and involvement in various social and community activities.
- Enhance the development and understanding of Aboriginal Culture in the wider footprint community.
- Support wider community activities/events, for example ‘NAIDOC’ activities and other Aboriginal calendar activities/events across the footprint.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants **must** be a legal registered entity with their own ABN/ACN, or endorsed through an organisation which holds an ABN/ACN.
- Applicants must have experience in delivering the proposed events/activities
- Successful applicants **must** deliver their activity, in full, within 12 months of receiving the funds.
- At the completion of their activity successful applicants must provide a financial statement certified by the relevant ABN/ACN holder demonstrating that the funds were applied to the approved purpose.
- Applications for community activities which have already been completed will not be considered for funding (no retrospective funding).
- Applicants are encouraged to secure additional funds/in kind support from other sources to compliment funds from the Trust for their community activity.
- Applications for funding are capped up to \$7,500 (GST inclusive) per community activity.
